## STEPS IN THE PROCESS:

- 1--REASON IDENTIFIES WHAT IS BEHIND EVERY TRUTH
- 2--JOHN IS MORTAL BECAUSE HE IS A MAN AND ALL MEN ARE MORTAL
- 3-SEES REALITY AS A SERIES OF CONNECTED CAUSES, BUT WE
  NEVER CAN KNOW THE TOTAL (SO FAITH TAKES OVER) AS FOR
  EXAMPLE GOD BECOMES A PRACTICAL NECESSITY, AND KANT SEES
  DREAM PSYCHOLOGY FROM THIS PERSPECTIVE AS WELL
- 4--REASON HELPS US DETERMINE WHAT THE CATEGORIES ORGANIZE
- 5- -- 18TH VIEW--THE ROMANTICS SEE IMAGINATION AS THE HIGHER FUNCTION

ACT ACCORDING TO THE MAXIM BY WHICH YOU CAN AT THE SAME TIME WILL THAT IT SHOULD BECOME A UNIVERSAL LAW (CATEGORICAL IMPERATIVE)

REASON NEEDS FREEDOM TO ACT--

B--THE STUDENT WHO DOES NOT BECAUSE HE / SHE IS BEING WATCHED

SO THE MOTIVATION BECOMES DUTY--TO CONFORM ONE'S ACTIONS TO RIGHT REASON EVEN IF THE OUTCOME DOES NOT MATCH THE EXPECTATION

- 1--IF YOUR ACTION SHOULD BE A UNIVERSAL LAW--THAT IS FOR ALL TO DO REGARDLESS OF EMOTIONAL PRIVATE CIRCUMSTANCES
- 2--IF YOUR ACTION SHOULD BE A UNIVERSAL LAW OF NATURE--WHAT YOU WANT TO DO CONFORMS TO A LAW OF NATURE
- 3--TREAT HUMANITY AS AN END NOT A MEANS--ALL ARE ON THE SAME FOOTING DO TO REASON; PEOPLE ARE NOT TO BE USED...
